








Easy Pompom Maker Guide

Gather Your Materials:	
	<p>Pompom maker Yarn in your desired colour(s) Pen/Pencil Scissors Utility knife Circular shapes in desired sizes</p>
Open the Pompom Maker:	
	<p>Start by opening both sides of the pompom maker. You'll notice that each side consists of two semi-circular arms.</p>
Wrap Yarn Around One Side:	
	<p>Take the end of your yarn and place it between the arms of one side of the pompom maker. Hold it in place with your thumb.</p>
	<p>Begin wrapping the yarn around one arm of the pompom maker. Keep the wraps close together, covering the entire arm. Add additional colours if desired.</p>



	<p>Continue wrapping until you achieve your desired thickness.</p>
<p>Cut the Yarn:</p>	
	<p>Once you're satisfied with the thickness, close the first side of the pom-pom maker. Cut the yarn from the skein(s), leaving a small tail(s).</p>
<p>Repeat on the Other Side:</p>	
	<p>Repeat the wrapping process on the other side. This ensures both sides of your pom-pom are equally fluffy.</p>
<p>Close the Pom-pom Maker:</p>	
	<p>Once both sides are wrapped, close the pom-pom maker by snapping the arms together. Make sure it's securely closed.</p>



Cut the Yarn Between the Arms:

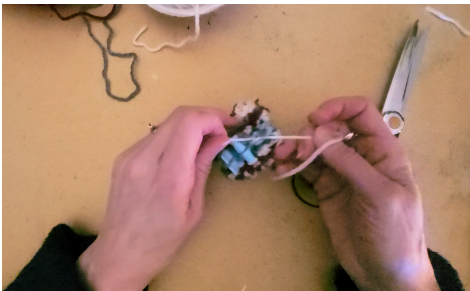


Using sharp scissors or a utility knife, carefully cut the yarn along the groove between the two sets of arms on both sides of the closed pom-pom maker.

Secure with Additional Yarn:

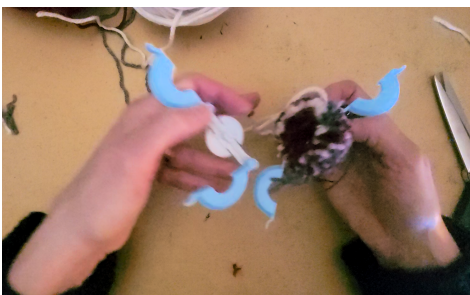


Cut a separate piece of yarn that is about 12-15" long. Insert it between the closed arms.





Tie it tightly around the center of the wrapped yarn. Make a double knot to secure. Do not cut this yarn. You'll use this later to secure it to your project.

Release the Pompom:



Gently open the arms of the pom-pom maker. Pull the pom-pom maker apart.



Trim and Shape:	
	<p>Trim any uneven strands to create a neat, round shape. Be mindful not to cut the securing yarn.</p>
Fluff and Finish:	
	<p>Give your pom-pom a good shake and fluff it up. Adjust the strands as needed for an even look.</p>
Attach to Your Dog Wear:	
	<p>Use the tails of the tying yarn to attach the pom-pom to your dog wear. You can sew it securely in place.</p>
