Easy Pompom Maker Guide

Gather Your Materials:



Pompom maker

Yarn in your desired colour(s)

Pen/Pencil

Scissors

Utility knife

Circular shapes in desired sizes

Open the Pompom Maker:



Start by opening both sides of the pompom maker. You'll notice that each side consists of two semi-circular arms.

Wrap Yarn Around One Side:




Take the end of your yarn and place it between the arms of one side of the pompom maker. Hold it in place with your thumb.



Begin wrapping the yarn around one arm of the pompom maker. Keep the wraps close together, covering the entire arm. Add additional colours if desired.








Cut the Yarn Between the Arms:



Using sharp scissors or a utility knife, carefully cut the yarn along the groove between the two sets of arms on both sides of the closed pompom maker.

Secure with Additional Yarn:



Cut a separate piece of yarn that is about 12-15" long. Insert it between the closed arms.



Tie it tightly around the center of the wrapped yarn. Make a double knot to secure. Do not cut this yarn. You'll use this later to secure it to your project.

Release the Pompom:



Gently open the arms of the pompom maker.
Pull the pompom maker apart.



Trim and Shape: Trim any uneven strands to create a neat, round shape. Be mindful not to cut the securing yarn. Fluff and Finish: Give your pompom a good shake and fluff it up. Adjust the strands as needed for an even look. Attach to Your Dog Wear: Use the tails of the tying yarn to attach the pompom to your dog wear. You can sew it securely in place.

Congratulations! You've successfully created a pompom with a Pompom maker. Feel free to experiment with different yarn colours and sizes to add variety to your dog wear creations. Enjoy the process of crafting with love and creativity!
